## **Exton Monument**

**About 10 Metres South of Church of St. Leonard**

Location – Churchyard of St. Leonard about 9 Metres north of Church, Sutton Veny, Wiltshire

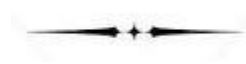
Grade II - Listed 1 July, 1986

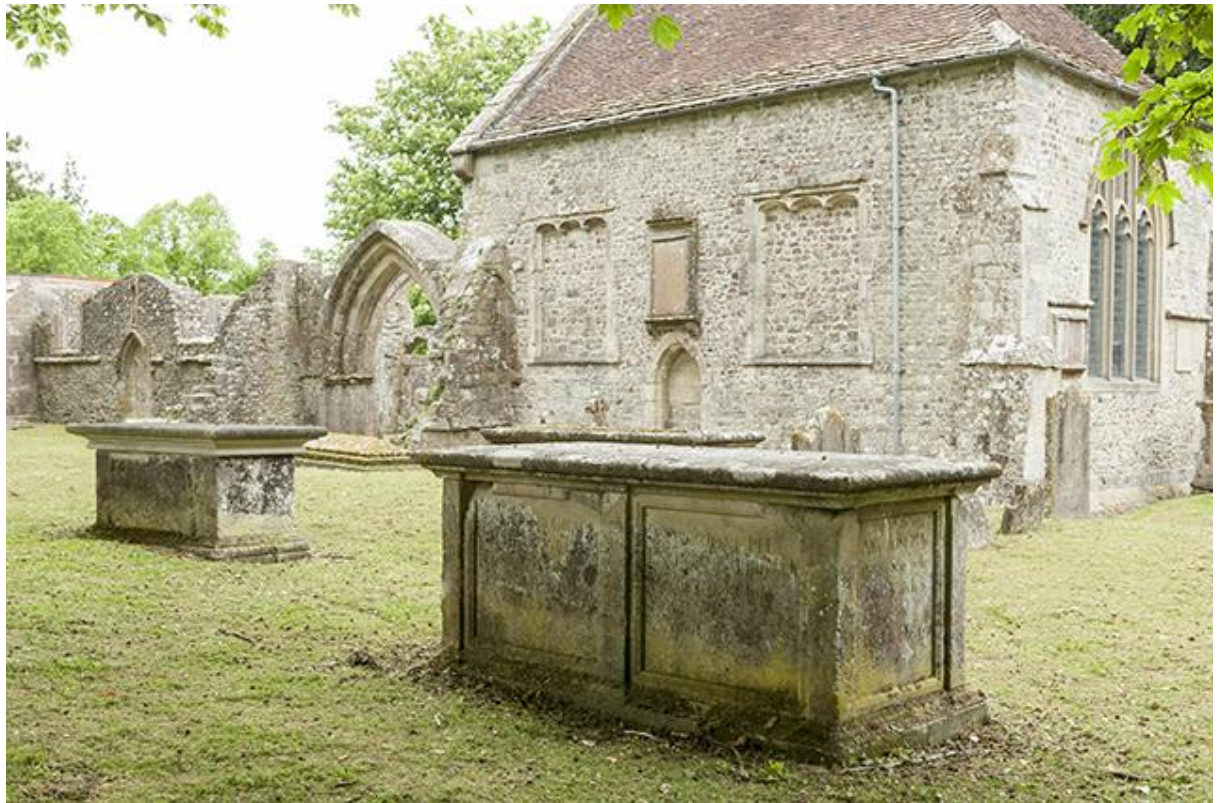
Chest tomb.

Grace Exton died 1750. Limestone. Two recessed moulded panels to main sides, plain corner pilasters, moulded flat top.

Partly sunk at time of survey (July 1985).

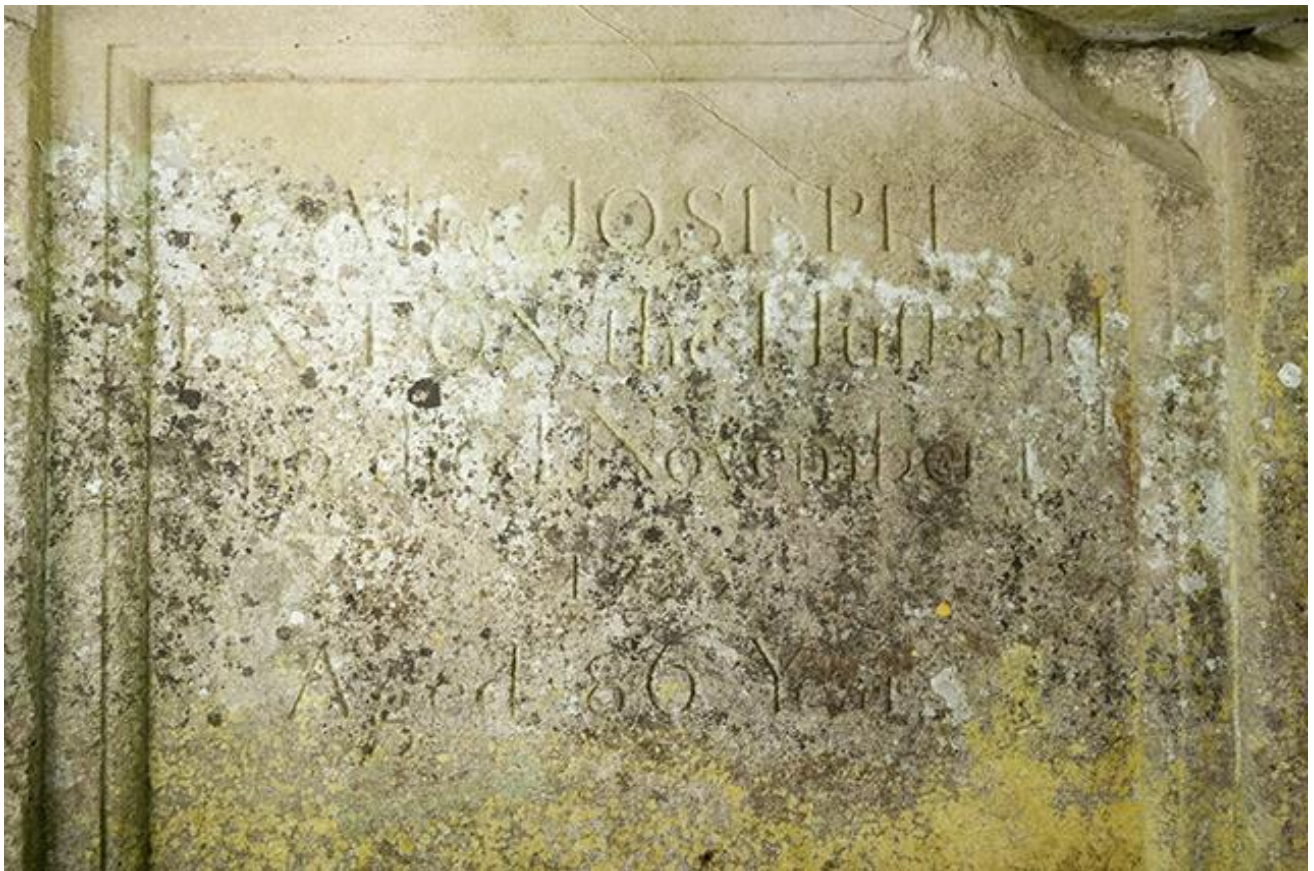
